Why Do I Still Promote Myself as a UFO Experiencer?

I've been writing about my contact with the interdimensional beings known as the Grays, since 1994, when I started my UFO journal. That diary eventually became my book *Abducted by Aliens*, in 2008. Today I'm 76 years old and I'm still at it, having just published its sequel, *Abducted by Angels*. The question is why. Why do I still write about Alien Abduction after all these years? The answer is simple, because apparently I'm the only voice out there still talking about our government's harassment of Abductee/ Experiencers, and its physical assaults on those who resist.

In Abducted by Angles I reprinted the lecture notes of Melinda Leslie, the last of the researchers who was brave enough to write about the re-abduction of contactees by a clandestine arm of the military, in order to learn what they know about Aliens, their flying craft and propulsion systems.² She admitted to me that her work is built on the investigations of other researchers, who were harassed so much that they eventually ceased their research and dropped out of sight. I understand that Ms. Leslie now resides in Sedona, Arizona, and provides tours for the tourists that visit that New Age Mecca. I seem to be the only one left standing to continue the fight.

My voice, though, has been a lone cry in the wilderness. My attempts to promote *Abducted by Aliens* and my three previous websites were sabotaged.³ Each time I dropped out to lick my wounds, only to come back later to try again. I suspect that few people ever heard of me.

With one notable exception, (OPUS)⁴, I've been shunned by the UFO community. Whitley Strieber, a self-admitted Abductee, and author of several books about his experiences, refused to talk with me, even though his graphic artist (who worked with him on a weekly basis) did the cover for my book, and suggested that I appear on his national interview program. After hearing me speak at a small gathering, the producer of George Noory's "Coast to Coast" radio show told me that he would talk with Mr. Noory about having me on. He seemed enthusiastic at the time, but I never heard back.

The most telling incident, though, was at the convention where I debuted my book. I tried to approach the organizer of the event about perhaps participating in a workshop on Alien Abduction. She took one look at me from across the room and, although we had never met, she literally ran away like a frightened rabbit. I couldn't approach her.⁵

A prominent researcher was even quoted in public as saying that the government is "NOT involved at all, end of story!" Why would anyone make such a pronouncement? It's absurd to think that our government wouldn't be involved in some way, even if only to monitor what's going on.

I believe Jim Keith, noted conspiracy researcher, when he said "On a number of occasions the UFO field has been infiltrated by military intelligence personnel, and well-known UFO 'researchers,' possibly even the majority of the prominent ones, have loyalties that seem not to reside with the UFO research community, or with the truth."

Anyone who tells what they know about the government's surveillance, harassment, and re-abduction of contactees, is marginalized and isolated from the rest of the UFO community. Researchers are allowed to continue their investigations, provided they stay clear of anything having to do with the involvement of Majestic, or the military. That's the one part of the equation that's strictly taboo, the "third rail" of UFO research. They've made a Faustian bargain, in order to be able to continue their work. It appears, that except for me, those who didn't have given up and gone home.
